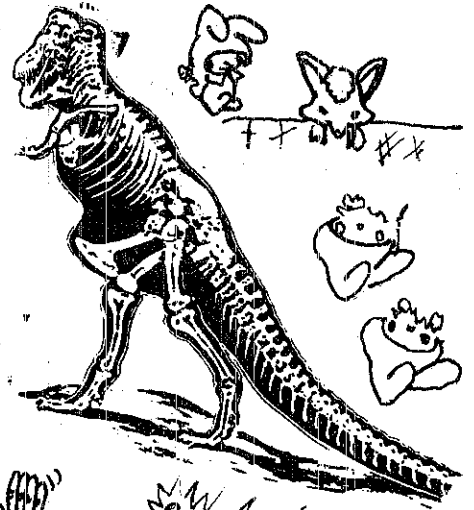

My morning shower was cut short when the hot water went on the fritz and scalded my face and body almost beyond recognition.

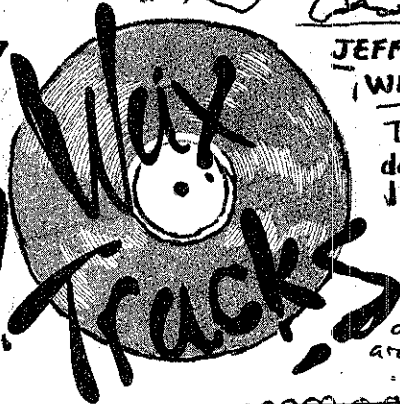
I went to wake my sister, only to discover she'd been brutally murdered.

Then this is INDEED your LUCKY DAY! I have a friend right here who can perform the operation.



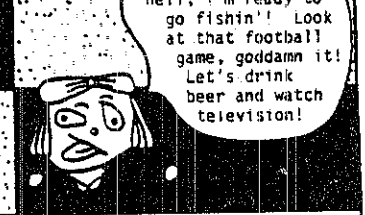

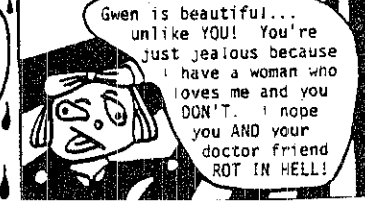
